

The state of the ministry in Haiti: some words from the field directors

1. We want to take this time to thank everyone who made it possible to be almost ready with the construction of the school. The construction will be used for the school, the college and Sunday school. The basket ball court will be used for the schools and the community. Thanks for this wonderful effort.
2. We also want to thank all of you who contribute money for the relief effort. The money was used to feed some elderly and some young people of the churches who are in need. We bought some rice and beans to distribute. We also distribute some toilet kits to ladies. We distribute some funds to some people. Thank you and thank you again
3. We would like to thank Fairmount Christian church and Chuck Catanese's church who contribute greatly to the relief effort. The money from Fairmount was used to finish the basket-ball floor.
4. Also many thanks to Fayetteville Christian Church that shows a great interest in this ministry, their contribution is really appreciated.
5. I have a plan to go to the States for two weeks. I am invited by a Haitian Church to preach one week of revival in Immokalee, Florida. This will be the week of April 4th through April 11th. The second week I will be in Atlanta meeting with Fayetteville Christian Church and another church. Possibly the same week, I will be available to visit with First Christian church of High Point, North Carolina.
6. We plan to reopen the school of Tabarre on April 5th. We will also take kids of the Tabarre community who cannot go to their school because of the events of January 12, 2010. We will try to provide for their education for the rest of the school year. We plan also to launch a special sponsorship for the school children. That will permit us to serve more kids by paying their tuition and possibly feed them everyday. If there is an organization or a church or individuals who would like to support this effort, please let us know immediately and we will give more information about how this can be done. Thank you in advance.
7. One year ago, we lost two of our ministers at the Church of Mirebalais. The church was without a leader on the field. After prayers and considerations, the church elected a new pastor. We will ordain him on April 25th. His name is Jeanson Janvier, a graduate of Christianville College with a degree in theology. He also is preparing a master's degree in education with FLET University, through the Baptist Haiti mission. We pray that the church will continue to grow again. We would like to find a church that can support the pastor. We plan to build him a house. We already have the land. That is a good cause to support!
8. I will start building my house in Mirebalais as soon as I come back from the States at the end of the month of April 2010. I am in need of some funds to do so. Please let me know how you can help me.
9. The family is doing well. We are still under shocks after the earthquake. The children cannot concentrate on their school work. Please continue to pray for us and the kids.
10. A team is supposed to come from Fairmount Christian Church in May 2010 to do some electrical work in the new building. We are hoping that they have a chance to be blessed and to bless us. Welcome to them already.
11. Attached is a report of the relief money contributed by our brothers and sisters in the USA. We will pray for you all who spontaneously send help to the people of Haiti. May God bless you all!
