Mirebalais Christian Church

First, the churches are going well. The church of Mirebalais is still growing. As you knew it, Pastor Rodney Decamp graduated last year and is the associate pastor of Mirebalais Christian church. He is doing a great job organizing the church and preaching. His wife just gave birth to a girl last month. Now he has 2 kids. I am still looking forward to helping him financially.



Tabarre Christian church

The church of Tabarre is doing great! Tabarre is nearby the airport of Port-au-Prince. We continue to grow tremendously. It is very stable. We have the project of construction and in fact it is under construction so far by faith. The gospel choir from the church came to sing at the commencement ceremony last month at Christianville. That was great. My new associate pastor's name is Thomas Saintus. He is in charge of Sunday school and he preaches once a month.



Last month, a brother from Muscogee, OK came to preach a revival at the church of Tabarre. Many people rededicated their lives to Christ. More than 40 people accepted the Lord and were baptized in the name of the Lord.
