Urgent needs for the ministry

We can buy in Haiti for \$30,000 or we can ship one from the states.

- We need to build a house on campus for Rodney and his family. The cost is approximately 12,000 dollars.
- A construction of the school of Mirebalais (approximately 20, 000 dollars)
- The enlargement of the church of Tabarre (approximately 12,000 dollars)
- School supplies for the 2005-2006 school year.

Haiti update

As many of you know, the security and safety in Haiti is at an all-time low. Kidnappings and car jackings are very common. Many ministries, including Logic, have suspended short-term missions trips. Pastor Avenel's travels within Haiti are very difficult without a car and made even more difficult since they are many places in the cities that are controlled by gangs.
